

## **Satan's dance with Christianity**

Satan was thrown out of the original creation when God recognized his mentality. He then wanted to go his own way in his wrath and build up a kind of alternative creation, which of course could not be compatible with the original creation. Satan then wanted to seize as much power as possible and manifest anger and hatred towards the original creator in his - actually - illusory creation. In the satanic secondary creation the actual creator God, the original creator, should better not be mentioned. He should be forgotten and otherwise rather appear like a devil. Somehow, Satan managed to bring one third of the angels in the original creation with him in his rather dark world, probably promising them to be able to live out their own egoism.

Then much later Yeshua (Jesus) came as messenger of Christ (this designation, "The Anointed One", can apparently be hypothetically connected with Mummu in the Sumerian creation story). Why messenger? Christ, of course, existed from the beginning of the creation; Yeshua appeared only two millennia ago to teach mankind. Through him, Christ wanted to give us important knowledge and truths that Satan wanted to keep from us. Around him a movement arose, which became a renewal of religion as Christianity. The original Christianity was, of course, what a number of people had learned directly from Jesus, especially his disciples, but also what others had heard in his public speeches. This knowledge spread throughout society, much to the displeasure of Satan, who wanted to conceal it.

Satan could not stop the spread of the new teaching at first. Then he came up with the idea of infiltrating it and transforming it into something more to his liking. This should then be an apparent Christianity, which would appear outwardly, as genuine but behind this facade would be censored and better adapted to his ideas. In many ways a counterfeit Christianity. Saul, who had initially fought against Christianity, was chosen by Satan and in an arranged vision ordered to proclaim a satanically inspired "counterfeit Christianity," after which he called himself Paul. Later, the Roman emperor Constantine realized that this teaching was beneficial for his power, in order to better control the Roman people. But, of course, Paul's version. The real one would not be to his liking (and this one probably would not have been understood by the emperor either). Beginning with the Council of Nicaea in 325, the remaining texts of early Christianity were then banned and destroyed.

However, the true Creator God was able to make important texts become hidden in order to escape destruction. A whole library of such original texts was found in 1945 in Nag Hammadi in Egypt, where Coptic Christians had hidden them. They form a comprehensive supplement to the "New Testament" in the Bible. Their content is referred to as "Gnostic Christianity," roughly "Christianity of the knowing ones." The Greek word "gnosis" means "knowledge," and so these texts add much knowledge to the Gospel.

Now, one must distinguish between a "Gnostic Christianity" and what is called "gnostic" in other circles simply because they think they know some things better. Among these are some circles of a Masonic nature gone astray in magic, such as Golden Dawn, Thelema, in the Middle Ages John Dee and Edward Kelly, and so on. These have nothing at all to do with Gnostic Christianity. (The fact that one sometimes includes the "Rosicrucians" will not be quite correct, because they are probably "in between" to some extent). However, for slandering such connections are claimed all too gladly, only because the true Gnostic Christianity is seen as threatening for ecclesiastical and other power structures. Also there power is unfortunately more important than truth!

## **Who then is Yahweh?**

The "Old Testament" is actually Yahweh's book and the "New Testament" is Jesus' book! In the "Old Testament" Yahweh is mentioned very often (6800 times), but in the "New Testament" not at all! Not even the Tetragrammaton "YHWH." For it, "Lord" (in Greek "kyrios") is used instead. Does it then really refer to the same one in these books?

In John 8, Jesus hinted at the answer:

31 Jesus therefore said to the Jews who believed in him ....

42 Jesus said to them: If God were your Father, ye would love me: for I am come forth, and am come from God: for I am not come of myself, but he hath sent me.

44 *Ye are of the father the devil, and after your father's pleasure will ye do. The same is a murderer from the beginning, and is not established in the truth; for the truth is not in him. When he speaketh lies, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of them.*

About whom did Jesus speak these words? And who is it that he himself names as his "father"? There will be only one meaningful way to understand these words: The "father, the devil" is YHWH! And Jesus-Christ's Father is a God higher than YHWH, the true original Creator God, in whose creation YHWH is an entity on a lower level, pretending to be the only God.

According to gnostic texts: Satan was thrown out and in the process transfigured into Yaldabaoth, who escaped to darker regions, where he established his own "creation" under the name of Yahweh. Another aspiration of Satan is the fragmentation of Christianity into several main groups and a larger number of sects. Unfortunately, it even seems that some sects are covertly under the influence of various entities claiming to be "Jesus." Then, again, being ignorant communities of sham Christians. The concept of "salvation", could then be faked! Can it be that there are – *horribile dictu* – cases in which Satan thereby binds souls to himself or some entity and let them believe that it is to Jesus?
